Summary Definition of Conflict of Interest

No Commission member or employee shall make, or participate in making, any decision in which he or she knows or should know he or she has a conflict of interest.

No Commission member or employee shall, in any way, use his or her position to influence any decision in which he or she knows or should know he or she has a conflict of interest.

ITEM 3: Reapportionment Requirement and Redistricting Procedures

SUMMARY:

Per CAC Law (Article 2.5, Sections 67041 and 67042) the Commission shall establish no fewer than three and no more than five districts, each representing approximately the same percentage of avocado production in California, which shall be reapportioned every fifth year in accordance with CAC-adopted redistricting procedures.

CAC Redistricting Procedures indicate that the first step of the reapportionment process is to review production data, collected for the five preceding fiscal years, to determine if existing district lines continue to equitably represent the California avocado industry. The procedures state that if it is determined the existing district composition does not best serve the California avocado industry, it shall utilize the most relevant production and industry statistical data available, including acreage inventories, to draw new district boundaries.

For reference, the CAC Law and Redistricting Procedures were modified in 2015 by the Governance Committee to provide Redistricting Committees greater discretion in analyzing existing districts and proposing new district boundaries. Words like "approximately", "equitably" and "best serve" were purposefully selected to allow the Committee to take into consideration districts that are comprised of producers who share similar growing conditions and industry issues, as well as a relatively equal percentage of avocado production.

Included in the meeting materials are the applicable sections of the CAC Law, CAC Redistricting Procedures, as well as 2021-2025 production and acreage data, by existing CAC district. The Committee should review this data prior to the February 18, 2026 meeting and be prepared to discuss and make a recommendation regarding reapportionment.

ARTICLE 2.5. Districts

(Article 2.5 added by Stats. 1980, Ch. 721.)

67041.

The commission shall establish no fewer than three districts and no more than five districts within the state, each representing approximately the same percentage of avocado production in California.

(Amended by Stats. 2015, Ch. 307, Sec. 2. Effective January 1, 2016.)

67042.

Beginning in the 2000–01 marketing season, districts shall be reapportioned every fifth year in accordance with redistricting procedures adopted by a two-thirds vote of the commission and concurred in by the secretary.

(Amended by Stats. 2015, Ch. 307, Sec. 3. Effective January 1, 2016.)

Adopted by CAC Board November 19, 2015
Concurred in by the Secretary February 25, 2016
Approved by CAC Board March 17, 2016

REDISTRICTING PROCEDURES

California Avocado Commission (Commission) law (California Food and Agricultural Code Section 67042) requires that the Commission establish procedures for the purpose of redistricting. The established procedures shall be as follows:

1. **Composition.**

As defined in law, the Commission shall be composed of no fewer than three (3) and no more than five (5) districts within the state, each representing a relatively equal percentage of the avocado production in California.

2. **Reapportionment.**

Districts shall be reapportioned every fifth year in accordance with the following redistricting procedures:

- A. The Commission shall review production data, collected for the five preceding fiscal years, to determine if existing district lines continue to equitably represent the California avocado industry.
- B. If the Commission determines that the existing district composition does not best serve the California avocado industry, it shall utilize the most relevant production and industry statistical data available, including acreage inventories, to draw new district boundaries.
 - 1. The production data used by the Commission to support the need for redistricting shall be the same production data used to draw new district boundaries.
- C. The Commission shall configure new districts in a manner that equitably represents its constituents and consisting of no fewer than three and no more than five districts, each representing a relatively equal percentage of the avocado production in California.
 - 1. The redrawn districts shall strive to:
 - i. Represent a relatively equal percentage of the avocado production, with a variance goal of no more than 10 percent.
 - ii. Be composed of avocado producing areas that are as contiguous as practicable.

- D. The Commission shall complete the reapportionment process and approve redrawn district boundaries, by a two-thirds vote, no later than March 31 of the fiscal year prior to the new districts' effective date. New district boundaries shall become effective with the commencement of the new fiscal year, November 1, and remain in effect for a period of five years.
- E. In the event that the Commission is unable to agree upon district boundaries by a two-thirds vote, by March 31, the Commission shall notify the secretary who shall, within 10 days of receiving the notification, appoint an arbitrator. The arbitrator shall, within 80 days, reapportion existing districts to comply with the reapportionment procedures outlined above.

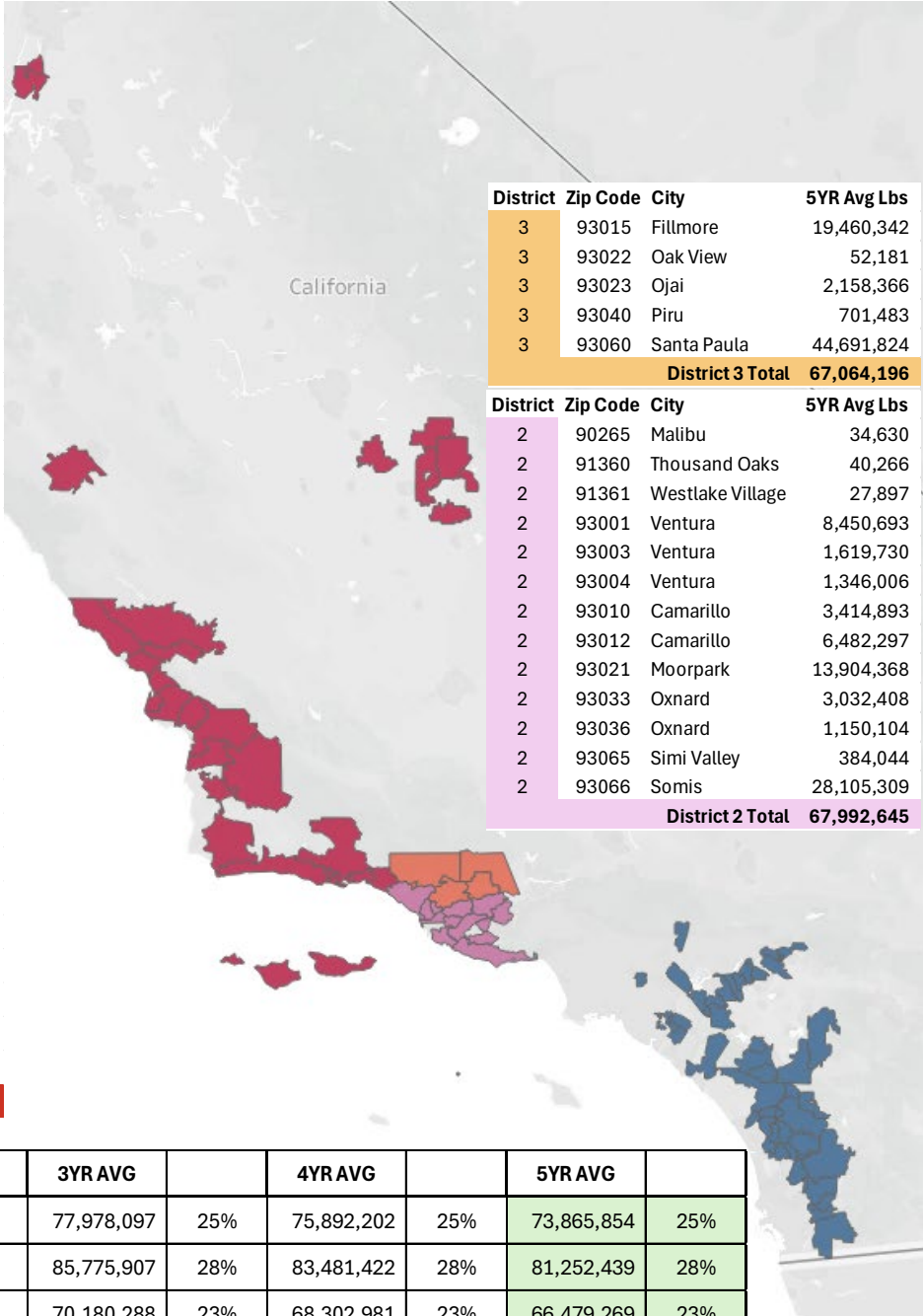

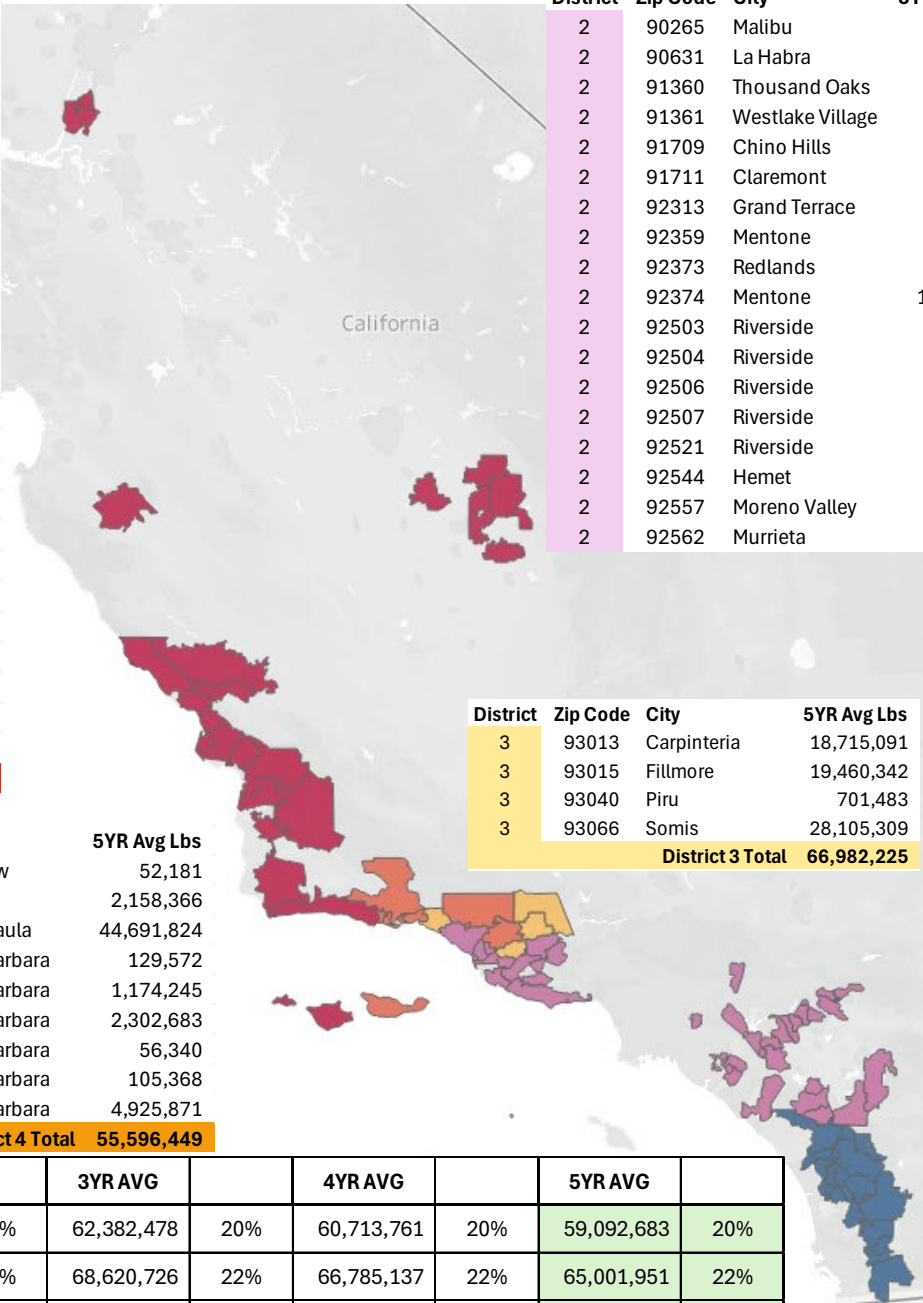
