



Ag Pass Training

In order for an applicant to be issued an Ag Pass, you must attend one of these mandatory training sessions:

July 7th 8am- Noon

SBC Office of Emergency Management
4408 Cathedral Oaks Rd, Santa Barbara

Possession of an Ag Pass during a wildfire or a similar disaster potentially allows the agriculturalist limited emergency access to areas that may otherwise be restricted to the public, in order to :

- 1) protect or care for agricultural assets*
- 2) provide support information to emergency personnel*

*Ag Pass cards are applied for by and distributed to eligible agriculturalists **BEFORE** a disaster.*
